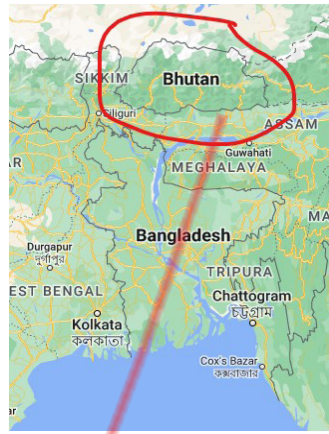

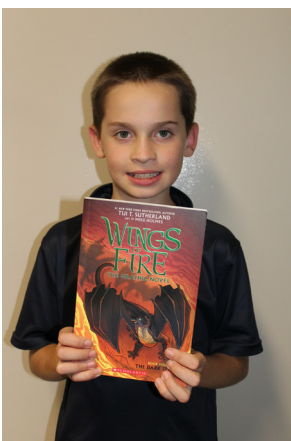
Adele and Clarisse are from the Democratic Republic of the Congo which is in Central Africa.
